

LR 22 Silhouette Match – August 20, 2022

Format

Course of fire; 10 shots each, chickens at 50 yards standing offhand, pigs, turkeys and rams at 100, 150, and 200 yards respectively, either prone or off the bench at the shooters option with front rest only, no rear support. Targets will be a mixture of regular and small (NRA rifle) sizes.

Notes

This is a one rifle match; a competitor must use the same rifle across all four stages. If you have an issue with your rifle or sights, you may request an alibi from the match director.

Front rests may be cross sticks or bipods only. Sandbags or benchrest type front rests are not allowed. No rear support, either sandbags or any other rest, is allowed.

For standing shots on the chickens, you may not lean against the benches, posts, or other type of artificial support.

The Poulsbo Sportsman Club website has been updated as follows:

“Due to range limitations and in the interest of completing the match in a reasonable timeframe, the number of shooting positions is limited to 32, spread across 4 relays of 8 shooters each. Preregistration is strongly encouraged; walk-ons will be accepted the day of the match only as positions are available. Preregistration will accommodate only the first three relays. If a fourth relay is necessary, it will be squadded the morning of the match.”

Donna Jean Bruce will be handling preregistration and in-person registration. Jerry Prouty will collect the \$10 match fee and dispense drawing tickets.

Setup will begin at 8:15 AM Saturday morning. Please come at that time and assist Art Betz with setup and other tasks so the match can begin promptly at 9:00 AM.

Prizes and Drawings

The Match Winner will have first pick of raffle prizes. The remaining prizes will be awarded by drawing names from the tickets distributed at time of match check-in. We will also offer stickers/pins to those who qualify.

Food

There will be a table set up for coffee. Please bring cookies, doughnuts or other food items to share with your fellow shooters. As a reminder, no food or beverage may be consumed inside the shooting area due to regulations by the Washington Department of Labor and Industries.
