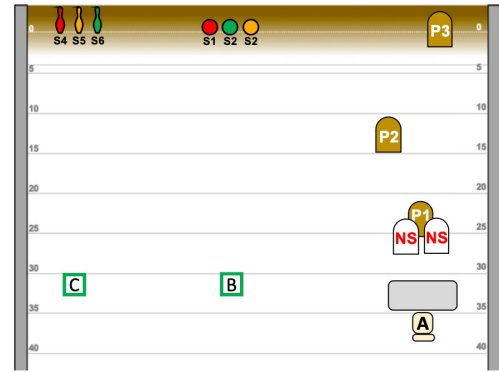

Stage 1: "Santa's Workshop"

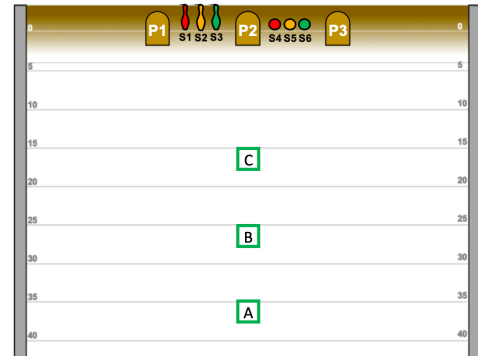
This stage requires the shooter to first engage targets from a seated position, then engage steel targets from different positions while retrieving magazines from the table. 30 rounds and 3 magazines required for this stage.



1. Shooter sets out empty weapon and 3 magazines (loaded with 6 rounds each) on table and sits in chair "A" at the table.
2. On start, Shooter remains seated, retrieves weapon and 1 magazine, puts weapon into action, and engages paper targets P1-P3 (10,20,30 ft away) with three (2) rounds each, by shooting over the table.
3. Shooter then executes a slide-lock reload using a magazine off the table, then gets up from the chair and moves to "B" WHILE KEEPING THE MUZZLE DOWNRANGE.
4. At "B," Shooter engages steel targets S1-S3 (steel round, 30ft)
5. Shooter then moves to "C" and engages steel targets S4-S6 (steel pin, 30ft)
6. If a reload is needed, Shooter MUST RETURN to table and retrieve

Stage 2: "Grip-X-Change"

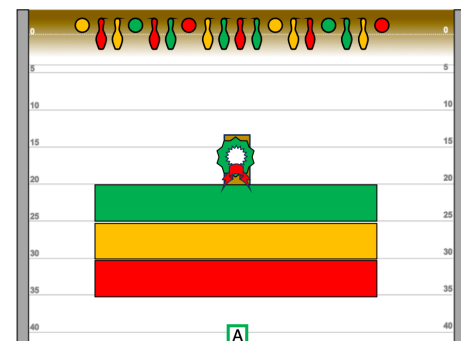
This stage challenges the shooter to engage a variety targets using two-handed, strong-handed, and weak-handed shooting from a series of successively closer positions. Minimum of 24 rounds and 3 magazines total are required to complete stage, assuming all hits on steel. No specific magazine requirements for this stage.



1. Shooter loads and makes ready in box "A" (35 ft.) and awaits start.
2. On start, shooter engages paper targets P1, P2, and P3 with 2 rounds each
3. Shooter then engages ONE ROUND steel target (S1-3) and ONE PIN steel target (S4-6) in any order.
4. Shooter then executes a mandatory reload while moving to B.
5. At B, Shooter repeats steps 1-3 with STRONG HAND ONLY
6. Shooter then executes a mandatory reload while moving to C.
7. At C, Shooter repeats steps 1-3 with WEAK HAND ONLY

Stage 3: "Through the Wreath"

This stage challenges the shooter to engage different sets of steel targets, grouped by color, from corresponding areas while engaging through a wreath opening. This stage requires 18 rounds minimum, assuming all hits on steel.



1. Shooter loads makes ready with three rounds (weapon safe and holstered) in box "A,"
2. At the start, shooter draws and begins engaging all steel targets.
3. All shots must be THROUGH the barricade opening. Shoot must engage all six steel targets of each color (two rounds, four pins) from the corresponding color-zone on the ground.
